Two problems were fixed:

- A bug in the recovery image that could cause a reboot loop
- A bug in vTBA causing a WiFi driver crash when using more than 28 Trust Domains

P Issue Summary

A bug was introduced in the recovery 2.32.0 release that could cause the VeeaHub to enter a boot loop from which is it unable to recover. This bug could be triggered IF the VeeaHub suffered a WAN connectivity occurring after the VeeaHub had connected to the VeeaCloud AND the WAN connectivity outage lasted longer than 4 hours AND the VeeaHub was already part way through upgrading its recovery release when the WAN connectivity failure occurred.

Release Notes

The recovery code was modified to properly handle errors during image upgrade.

Simultaneously connecting Wifi clients to more than 28 separate Trust Domains on a VeeaHub that is running vTBA will cause the VeeaHub to reboot.

The limit on the maximum number of VLANs in the Wi-Fi driver is increased to 256 which allows each client to connect with a different Trust Domain.
